What does this role look like at YMCA Calgary?

Reporting to the Vice President, Fund Development, the Manager, Fund Development works to identify, cultivate, solicit and steward major and annual gift prospects to establish and meet the annual fundraising strategic goals. The components of YMCA Calgary's fundraising strategy include an annual giving program; YMCA Strong Kids Campaign, Heritage Club (endowment campaign) and a Major Gifts for Program and Capital. This manager will also have duties pertaining to the strategy and execution for an ongoing significant capital campaign. A key function of this position is to maintain long term relationships with donors through best stewardship practices in support of 'moves management' goals.

The Fund Development Manager will:

- Participate and provide leadership for the identification, cultivation, solicitation and stewardship of major gifts from foundations, corporations, community and individual donations
- Develop and maintain a prospect management system to support effective moves management for the fund development program
- Create and oversee a stewardship and recognition framework to ensure the highest level of accountability is provided to campaign and annual donors ensuring long-term, sustainable relationships are developed and maintained
- Manage a portfolio of major gift prospects and donors, developing strategies and implementing key actions to increase corporate, community and individual donation
- Cultivate potential new Heritage Club members and steward existing members
- Establish and maintain professional and productive relationships with key volunteers and donors
- Participate on the Strong Kids committee at the strategic and operational level and maintain open communication in support of YMCA Calgary's goals
- Take part in the Fund Development Committee of the Board, providing feedback, information and gathering assistance from the team for contacts in the community
- Meet with selected potential donors, through personal visits and written and oral communication, to discuss their desires regarding gifts to YMCA Calgary, helps them understand gift-giving vehicles and negotiates terms and conditions of gifts
- Attend networking opportunities with, professional and organizational affiliations and attends functions and events that serve to effectively identify and cultivate business and individual donor relationships
- Work collaboratively with Vice President, Fund Development, President and CEO and fundraising volunteers to identify and steward key philanthropic relationships and potential prospects

- A rich and deep understanding of YMCA Calgary's work in the community and a personal and thoughtful ability to tell the YMCA story
